ALL are True/False

1. A parent can legally take away your right to drive if you are 16-17 years old.
2. Drivers with temporary permits can drive as long as they have a licensed driver with them who is 16 years or older.
3. As a driver **16 years old or younger**, Ohio law restricts you from:
 - a. Nothing - There are no restrictions
 - b. Driving between midnight and 6 am
 - c. Having more than one passenger who is not a family member in the vehicle
 - d. Driving without a licensed adult (21 or older) in the car until you pass the driver's test
4. As a **17 year old driver**, Ohio law restricts you from:
 - a. Nothing - There are no restrictions
 - b. Driving between 1am and 5am
 - c. Having as many passengers as seat belts in the vehicle
5. Once you pass the driver's test, you can drive when you want and with as many passengers as you want.
6. If you are under 18, it is **illegal** to use this electronic device while driving in Ohio:
 - a. Cell phones for texting and email
 - b. Tablets (iPads)
 - c. Cell phones for calls
 - d. Video games
 - e. GPS
 - f. Laptop computers
 - g. Cell phone hands free with Bluetooth, Bluetooth speakers, On-Star, etc.
 - h. Pre-programmed GPS
